Stitch count – 99 wide x 105 high (3,353 full cross stitches)
Linen - 32 ct. White Linen, Charles Craft
Threads – DMC 121 – variegated
DMC 820

Stitching Instructions

Cross stitch over two linen threads with two strands of DMC. Use DMC 121 for the center motif and DMC 820 for the surrounding motifs.
